Group Case Study – Session #1

- **Assemble with your Team**
- **Objective:** Arm TAC members with an analytical toolkit/checklist for future use
- **Case Study:** The executive team at your company has identified a target acquisition. Your group is tasked with requesting data from the target company to properly evaluate if this company is a suitable 'fit' for your current operation. You are not being asked to evaluate the capabilities of the target's management team or personnel. For this team workshop challenge, your group is tasked with:

Group Case Study – Session #1

- **Creating a list of datasets which you would request from the target company.**
- **Determine how you would utilize this data, in conjunction/parallel with datasets from your company, to make a recommendation to proceed/not proceed with the acquisition.**

Group Case Study – Session #1

- **Attributes of Buyer**
 - 200 Trucks / 410 Trailers
 - Dryvan
 - Current network – Upper Midwest US
 - 650 mile Length of Haul
 - \$5 Million Brokerage
- **Attributes of Seller**
 - 550 Trucks / 1200 Trailers
 - 90% Dryvan / 10% Refrigerated
 - Current network – Southeast US
 - 710 mile Length of Haul
 - \$10 Million Brokerage

Right-sizing Operations Using Analytics

- **Summary** – during freight market contractions, many trucking companies do not react as quickly as they should to the changing market. These actions include:
 - **Reducing tractor / trailer counts**
 - **Right-sizing operations team**
 - **Focus on cost-containment**
 - **Analyzing the current state of the freight that is being tendered/offered to them**

Right-sizing Operations Using Analytics

- **Discussion Topics:**
 - From an analytics perspective, where do you start the process of evaluating and right-sizing your business / your company's current strategy.
 - Specific data that you use in this process.
 - Evaluating the freight you have versus 'had'.

Right-sizing Operations Using Analytics

- **Discussion Topics:**
 - **Re-evaluating your network.**
 - **Debt considerations.**
 - **Current used equipment market.**
 - **Maintenance considerations and cost-savings.**
 - **Predictive – the downstream effect of reduced tractor and trailer count on service (for when the market swings).**
